1. This permit is issued pursuant to Section 9 of the City of Langley Highway and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2013, No. 2871. The issuance of this permit does not exempt, alter or waive any requirements of the Bylaw.

2. Applicants for highway use permits must submit evidence of commercial general liability insurance in the amount of \$5,000,000. All policies shall contain a cross-liability clause with the City named as an additional insured and shall be kept valid for the entire period of work.

4. Traffic control is the responsibility of the Permit holder. Traffic control shall comply with Part 18 of the OH& S Regulation of WorkSafeBC and the current edition of "BC Traffic Control Manual for Work on Roadways" published by the Ministry of Transportation and in addition the requirements of any Traffic Management plan attached to this permit.

5. Failure to comply with any City Bylaw or the terms and conditions of this permit will result in the cancellation of this permit and could result in fines under the Bylaw
