Applications are invited for Engineering Workers for Temporary Full-Time and Casual assignments in the Engineering Operations Division of the Engineering, Parks and Environment Department. Road construction and maintenance tasks and other physical duties may also be assigned.

RATE OF PAY: \$28.51 per hour

HOURS OF WORK: Temporary Full- Time hours are 40 hours per week
Casual hours are up to 40 hours per week

Temporary Full Time employees are paid 6% of their regular earnings in lieu of paid vacation and become eligible for benefits after 6 months of continuous employment. Casual employees are paid 12.5% of their regular earnings in lieu of all benefits.

The successful candidates will have Grade 12 plus experience in general construction and maintenance. A valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's License is required. Successful candidates will be required to undergo a criminal record check before commencing employment.
