Applications are invited for Casual Lifeguard/Instructors to work in the Recreation, Culture and Community Services Department at Al Anderson Memorial Pool. Lifeguard/Instructors are responsible for promoting participation in aquatic activities, practicing good public relations, providing supervision of the public within the pool complex, assisting with special events, and preparing and completing plans, records, and forms at the beginning and end of instructional sessions. The assignments start on May 7, 2018 and ends on August 31, 2018.

RATE OF PAY: Lifeguard / Instructor: \$26.72 - \$27.55 per hour

HOURS OF WORK: Up to 40 hours per week.
(Monday to Sunday including days, afternoons, evenings, and weekends)

Casual employees are paid 12.5% of their regular earnings in lieu of benefits and paid annual vacation.

A valid Standard First Aid Certificate, National Lifesaving Award, Basic Rescuer CPR, Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, and Lifesaving Instructor Award are required.
